### **Message from the President, SLACPT**

I am pleased to write this message for the SLACPT newsletter. The main activity for 2017 was the Scientific sessions held under the theme "Clinical Pharmacology for safe use of medicines". The sessions were held on 13<sup>th</sup> – 14<sup>th</sup> October at the Lionel memorial Auditorium. On the 13<sup>th</sup> morning a Pre – congress workshop was held on "Development of National Guidelines" with



the assistance of resource persons, Professor Rob Moulds and Ms Mary Hemming from Therapeutic Guidelines Limited, Australia. There was discussion on guideline development on Antibiotics, Respiratory disorders and Cardiovascular disorders. About 50 participants attended the workshop and the feedback received from the participants was encouraging. On 13<sup>th</sup> evening the Presidential induction and inauguration of the scientific sessions was held. My Presidential address was on "Challenges of a Clinical Pharmacologist in Sri Lanka". The highlight of the evening was the SLACPT oration delivered by Professor Rob Moulds on "Clinical Pharmacology – where to next". On the 14th the Scientific sessions continued with two plenary lectures on important topics in Clinical Pharmacology delivered by eminent academics and also comprised three symposia on "Quality use of medicines", "Combating antimicrobial resistance(AMR)" and "Pharmacology for the Clinician" Ten free paper sessions showcasing research carried out by pharmacologists and pharmacists were also an important component of the sessions. "A pocket guide on paediatric prescribing" by Dr Thilanka Seneviratne was also launched. I thank all resource persons, authors of research papers, members of the Council and all others who contributed towards making the scientific sessions productive and successful.

During the coming months it is planned to have outstation clinical meetings in Galle, Peradeniya and Batticaloa. The first meeting will be held on 21<sup>st</sup> June at the Medical Faculty, University of Ruhuna in collaboration with the Galle Medical Association.

As AMR is a significant public health problem in this country as well as globally, SLACPT hopes to conduct national surveillance on antibiotic use covering all districts. Professor Shalini Sri Ranganathan also plans to collaborate a research project on AMR with the University of York. Clinical pharmacologists from most medical faculties will also be involved along with the Ministry of Health in conducting these projects.

I would also like to pay a tribute to Professor Laal Jayakody, the Founder President of SLACPT who retired from service recently from the University of Colombo for his contribution in developing the discipline of Clinical Pharmacology. I wish him all success for the future.

Sri Lanka Association of Clinical Pharmacology and Therapeutics (SLACPT) Scientific Session 2017 was held on 14th October 2017 at the Lionel Memorial Auditorium, Sri Lanka Medical Association. The theme for the session was "Clinical Pharmacology for Safe use of Medicines".

The National Science Foundation was the Co-organizer of the function.

There were 2 plenary lectures. The first lecture was on Therapeutic targets and recent advances in immunopharmacological models by Prof Menik Hettihewa and the second was on evolving role of beta-2 agonists in asthma by Dr Channa Ranasinha.

The three symposia were on Quality use of medicines, Combating antimicrobial resistance, and Pharmacology for the Clinician.
