INSTRUCTIONS FOR AUTHORS

ABSTRACT FORMAT

- The word count should not exceed 300 words of text.
- Abstract needs to be structured (Background, Methods, Results and Conclusion).
- The title should be in capital letters.
- Names of all the authors should be given as surname followed by initials. **DO NOT** use prefixes such as Dr., Prof., Mr., Ms., etc. **DO NOT** include qualifications.
- The presenting author should be underlined.
- List affiliations of each author denoted by superscript roman numbers.
- The body of the text should be typed in Times New Roman (font size 12). Double spaced. Use Arabic numerals and SI units throughout.
- The abstract should describe original work, and indicate the purpose of the study, methods and materials used, statistical techniques employed and results obtained. Statements such as “conclusions will be discussed at the session” are unacceptable.
- Abstracts should be sent via e-mail to abstracts@slacpt.lk

Abstracts not conforming to the requirements (given above) will be rejected straightaway or returned for compliance. Abstracts rejected straightaway will not be accepted again for review.

Two reviewers will independently review the abstracts based on pre-determined criteria. The decision of the reviewers will be final. Corresponding authors are expected to re-submit the amended abstracts (in case of acceptance with changes) on or before given deadline.

All presenting authors of the accepted abstracts should register for the annual sessions. Details will be e mailed upon acceptance of the abstract.

Abstract submission deadline: 31st March 2026
